Attached please find a proposed budget for the Juvenile Justice/Delinquency Prevention Commission (JJDPC) for 1998/99 for inclusion in the budget hearing to take place in June 1998. The entire budget totals \$10,5 15 and represents minimal anticipated expenses for twelve meetings annually.

The JJDPC is one of the eight county commissions required by law. Its responsibilities are to insure that youth in Santa Cruz County who fall under the jurisdiction of the Juvenile Court are treated humanely and that their rights are protected as outlined under the laws of the State of California.

Here-to-fore, the administrative support of this commission has been provided by the County Probation Department. One of the required responsibilities of the of the JJDPC is an annual inspection of the Juvenile Hall facility, policies and procedures. Because the findings of this Commission may at times be critical, utilizing Probation Department clerical staff and supplies in the conduct of the Commission's business may be a conflict of interest. The JJDPC respectfully requests that the commission have a stand-alone budget.
