AGRICULTURAL CONSERVATION EASEMENT PROGRAM

Dear Members of the Board:

On April 28. 1998 your Board directed the Planning Department to return on this date with a status report on the Santa Cruz County Agricultural Conservation Easement (ACE) Program. As you know, staff is working with the Trust for Public Land and the Open Space Alliance towards the expenditure of funds granted under the California Wildlife. Coastal and Park Land Conservation Act of 1988 (Proposition 70) for the purchase of agricultural conservation easements on a portion of the Coast Dairies Lands and Cardoza Dairy on Harkins Slough Road in Watsonville.

Staff is reviewing the draft Deeds of Agricultural Conservation Easements and the Purchase and Sale Agreements. Once these documents are submitted into escrow and the escrow instructions are signed, the County may request payment of the grant funds. This will effectively secure the use of these funds even though the escrows will not close until after the June 30. 1998 statutory deadline.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board direct the Planning Department to return on or before June 16. 1998 with the Deed of Agricultural Conservation 'Easement and the Purchase and Sale Agreement for the Coast Dairies Land and Cardoza Dairy for your Board's final approval.
