Judge Samuel S. Stevens has issued Orders against me absent all jurisdiction and same Orders have prejudiced me and injured me in the amount of \$375,000.

Judge Samuel S. Stevens had a duty to Claimant (Ioane) to obey the federal court ... Order and to treat (Ioane) Me with fairness and without prejudice. Judge Samuel S. Stevens has failed to comply with the basic rules of a Judge. He is not immune from prosecution or civil penalties see: Pulliam v. Allen Supreme Court 1983;

This Claimant believes and so this Claimant states that Judge Samuel S. Stevens has a financial interest in the defendants and therefore Ioane can never get a fair hearing from this Judge. The English lords wrested by force of arms from King John the promise that "To no one will we sell, to no one will we refuse or delay right or justice." In the case of Judge Samuel S. 

I, Michael Scott loane, on first hand information and belief, do hereby attest to the following facts: that on or about Santa Cruz County Superior Court Judge Samuel Stevens on April 22, 1998 did commit a:

Violation of California Penal Code section 487, Grand Theft, California Penal code section 422.6 - no person shall willfully injure, intimidate or interfere with, oppress, or threaten any other person in the free escreise or enjoyment of any right secured by the Constitution or laws of California, and California Penal Code section 182 -- conspiracy to cheat and defraud any person of any property, or to obtain property by false pretenses.

Having forcknowledge and under color of legal authority, Santa Cruz County Superior Court Judge Samuel Stevens committed grand theft with the will of intent to cheat and defraud affiant of certain real property located within Santa Cruz County by taking a financial interest in the subject matter, or in defendants in the case of Louil No. CV 133337, and aided and abetted Edward A. Treder, and Robert D. McKinley from being responsible for their vicarious criminal liability by not requiring either Edward A, Treder, and Robert D. Plaintiff Michael Scott Ioane (hereinafter "Ioane") hereby disqualifies Superior Court Judge Samuel Stevens for cause on the ground that a person aware of the facts might reasonably entertain a doubt that judge Samuel Stevens would be able to be impartial, and that judge Samuel Stevens has a financial interest in the subject matter in the proceeding or in a party to the proceeding the record in this case in so far considered and referenced as though set forth in **full** herein.

In support hereof, Ioane respectfully shows unto this Court:

1. On April 22, 1998 Judge Samuel Stevens issued an order in clear absence of all jurisdiction setting aside the automatic stay order of the federal bankruptcy court in violation of Title 11 United States Code section 362, and Title 28 United States Code 'section 2283.

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- 2. On April 22, 1998, Judge Samuel Stevens issued an order setting aside the automatic stay order of the federal bankruptcy court in retaliation to Joane's tort claim.
- 3. Judge Samuel Stevens, having foreknowledge that notices of appearances have not been filed as required by C.C.P. § 1014, that the defendants are in default, and having advocated for and on behalf of the defendants; Judge Samuel Stevens has a financial interest in the subject matter in this proceeding, or in defendants to **these** proceedings.
- 4. Judge Samuel Stevens, having foreknowledge that notices of appearances have not been filed as required by C.C.P. § 1014, that the defendants are in default, and having advocated for and on behalf of the defendants; Judge Samuel Stevens is beholden to defendant Bank United and it's parent company the Federal Reserve, a private banking cartel, Lewis v. United States, 680 F.2d 1239 (9th Cir. 1982), and therefore Judge Samuel Stevens has a financial interest in the subject matter in this proceeding, **cr** in defendants to these proceedings.
- 5. **Incorporated** herein and made a part hereof by reference and attached as exhibit A. Demand to Santa Cruz Sheriff for Citizens arrest upon Judge Samuel S. Stevens, Affidavit of probable cause for arrest upon Judge Samuel S. Stevens, Tort claim filed against Judge Samuel S. Stevens.

During the pendency of this disqualification, Ioane hereby demands that Judge Samuel Stevens cease and desist from any further participation in this case pursuant to C.C.P. § 170.4.

Wherefore, the foregoing considered, Ioane demands a hearing to conduct an examination of Judge Samuel Stevens before another judge of this Court in the issues raised by this disqualification for cause, and not limited thereto. . .


