Subject: Contract Amendment for Preparation of Supplemental EIR for the Scott Creek Beach Access and Dune Enhancement Plan

Dear Members of the Board:

On August 1, 1995, your Board approved a contract with Simpson Environmental for preparation of a Supplemental Environmental Impact Report and Environmental Assessment for the Scott Creek Beach Access and Dune Enhancement Plan. These documents are necessary to comply with requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act and the National Environmental Policy Act arid to complete permit processing of this project proposed by the County Parks Department.

Simpson Environmental has recently been dissolved by its owner, who has established the new firm of Insite Environmental. Due to the name change and revised billing rates, an amendment to the existing contract must be approved by your Board. The requested amendment does not change the contract amount. This contract will be placed on the Continuing Agreements List, as the work will be carried out during fiscal year 1998/99. The proposed contract amendment has been included for your review as Attachment 1.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board authorize the Planning Director to execute an amendment to the contract with Simpson Environmental/Insite Environmental to provide for a change of name of the firm and revised labor rates.
