## DETERMINATION OF DISABILITY RETIREMENT OF SAFETY MEMBER

Dear Members of the Board:

Mr. Hallet Roberts has applied to the Public Employees' Retirement System (PERS) for a disability retirement. Under the terms of the Public Employees' Retirement Law, an employee is disabled if he cannot substantially perform the duties of the position he occupies. PERS requires that your Board provide, via a resolution, a determination of two issues: 1) whether Mr. Roberts is disabled (under the above-stated terms); and 2) whether his disability (if so determined) is "industrial" work related.

It is, therefore, RECOMMENDED that your Board approve the attached Resolution determining disability retirement of safety member, **Hallet** Roberts, as required under the Public Employees' Retirement Law.

## RESOLUTION DETERMINING DISABILITY RETIREMENT OF HALLET ROBERTS, DEPUTY SHERIFF

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz (hereinafter referred to as County) is a contracting agency of the Public Employees' Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the Public Employees' Retirement Law requires that a contracting agency determine whether a local safety member employee of such agency is disabled for purposes of Public Employees' Retirement Law and whether such disability is "industrial" within the meaning of such law; and

WHEREAS, an application for disability retirement of Hallet Roberts employed by the County in the position of Deputy Sheriff has been filed with the Public Employment Retirement System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has reviewed the medical and other evidence relevant to such disability;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors does hereby find and determine that Hallet Roberts is incapacitated within the meaning of the Public Employees' Retirement Law for performance of his duties in the position of Deputy Sheriff, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to Labor Code Section 3600, such disability is a result of employment and occurred in the course of employment with the County and is industrial;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such disability was not caused by negligence or an intentional act of a third party;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such disability is orthopedic;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the member be separated from his employment in the position of Deputy Sheriff effective June 26, 1998.
