SUBJECT: SOQUEL DRIVE 1998 STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECT

Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject emergency relief project are now complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The work, as approved by the California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) under the subject Damage Assessment Form (DAF), allows for the repair of a **slipout** on Soquel Drive, which resulted from the February 1998 storms. This project will provide for construction of cribwall, rock slope protection, and erosion control measures.

The engineer's estimate for this work is \$15 1,000, including contingencies and overhead. Funding for this project has been made available through the Federal Highway Administration's "On System" road storm repair program which is administered by CALTRANS. This program is funded at a.100 percent reimbursement for all work completed during the first 180 days of the event (until August 1, 1998), excluding the County's administration expenses. After August 1, 1998, the rate of reimbursement is reduced to 88.53 percent. Funds for the local share of these expenses are made available from other 1997/98 Road Budget programs (estimated at approximately \$19,000).

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:'

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate, and authorize calling for bids.

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- 2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 A.M. on June 23, 1998.
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a notice to contractors for a ten-day period beginning June 7, 1998, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.
