FAMILY PRESERVATION AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS: FUNDING AUGMENTATION AND CONTRACT AMENDMENTS

Dear Members of the Board:

As you will recall, the 1993 Federal Family Preservation and Support Act offers communities across the country an opportunity to extend integrated service delivery systems in order to strengthen families and improve outcomes for children. Over a five year period, the County of Santa Cruz is receiving approximately \$500,000 to develop, expand, and evaluate Family Preservation and Support Program (FPSP) services to at-risk families. Recommendations for the use of these funds are developed annually by the Children's Network for approval by your Board. On September 23, 1997, your Board approved the distribution of Santa Cruz County's FPSP funds for Federal Fiscal Year 1997/98 in the amount of \$129,366, allocating a portion of the funds to the Family Resource Center Network (FRCN) and awarding contracts for FPSP activities to the Valley Resource Center, Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center, the Youth Resources Bank, and the Foundation of California State University, Monterey Bay. Subsequently, on March 24, 1998 your Board accepted grant funds from the California Endowment in the amount of \$156,000 to support the Family Resource Center Network's comprehensive work plan. At that time, you approved a contract with the Greater Bay Area Family Network to provide implementation consultation services to the FRCN.

In the spring of 1998, HRA was informed by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) that Santa Cruz County's FPSP allocation for Federal Fiscal Year 1997/98 was being augmented by \$14,473, increasing our County's annual allocation from \$129,366 to \$143,839. On April 15, 1998, the Policy Action Council/Executive Committee of the Children's Network developed recommendations for the utilization of the additional \$14,473. Of this amount, the Children's Network recommends: (1) that \$4,000 be added to HRA's contract with Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center to expand the provision of on-site child care to organizations offering parent education and support programs; and (2) that the remaining \$10,473 be directed to support the FRCN's efforts to build family leadership throughout the county. Through HRA's contract with the Greater Bay Area Family Resource Network, the FRCN will use this \$10,473 augmentation matched by \$7,766 in California Endowment grant funds to sponsor a county-wide Family Leadership Conference to be held in September. The total cost of this conference is \$18,179. The Greater Bay Area Family Resource Network will coordinate all logistics of the conference.

At this time, it is necessary to accept and appropriate the \$14,473 in additional FPSP revenue, and to approve the attached contract amendments adding \$4,000 to I-IRA's contract with Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center and \$18,179 to HRA's contract with the Greater Bay Area Family Resource Network.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board:

- 1. Approve the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$14,473 and appropriate these funds as described in the attached AUD 60; and
- 2. Approve the attached amendments adding \$4,000 to HRA's agreement with Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center, and \$18,179 to HRA's agreement with the Greater Bay Area Family Resource Network; and authorize the HRA Administrator to sign these amendments.

AMENDMENT #1 TO INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT #71389

The COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ, by and through the Human Resources Agency, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and FOOD & NUTRITION SERVICES, INC./FAMILY HEALTH EDUCATION CENTER, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR" hereby amend contract number 71389 which provides services from October 1, 1997 through September 30, 1998. The purpose of this amendment is to provide an augmentation in the amount of \$4,000 and to modify the contract Scope of Services and Budget. The provisions of this Amendment shall be effective from July 1, 1998 through September 30, 1998. All other provisions of said contract shall remain the same.

(A) Paragraph 2 is amended to read:

2. <u>COMPENSATION</u>. In consideration for CONTRACTOR accomplishing said result, COUNTY agrees to pay CONTRACTOR as follows:

Total Cost of \$12,546 to be paid in five installments on the following dates: December 15, 1997 (\$2,136); March 16, 1998 (\$2,136); June 15, 1998 (\$2,137); August 15, 1998 (\$4,000) and September 15, 1998 (\$2,137). Quarterly progress reports shall be submitted on these dates (with the exception of August 15, 1998) to the HRA Senior Analyst.

(B) Exhibit A ("SCOPE OF SERVICES") is amended as follows:

(1) Section 5 is amended to read:

- 5. CONTRACTOR shall ensure that collaborative partners utilize CCPEPP providers for a total of 114 sessions over the course of the contract period; sessions must run for a minimum of one and one-half hours; no one collaborative partner shall have access to more than 20 sessions during the contract period; CONTRACTOR shall develop an equitable system of allocating unrequested sessions in a timely manner.
- (2) Section 12 is added to Exhibit A as follows:
- 12. CONTRACTOR shall utilize up to \$1,000 of the contracted funds to conduct an assessment/evaluation of the CCPEPP project, to develop recommendations for expansion and/or improvement of the project model, to develop recommendations for how funding can be obtained to continue the project after the contract expires, how insurance issues and other logistical problems can be resolved, and to address other program issues and/or problems identified by CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR shall provide to COUNTY a written report of the assessment's results and recommendations no later than September 15, 1998.
- (C) Exhibit "B" ("CONTRACTOR BUDGET") is amended as attached.

AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT #81601

This is an amendment to Contract #81601 by and between the Santa Cruz County Human Resources Agency, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and the Greater Bay Area Family Resource Network, hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR". The purpose of this amendment is to modify the following three agreement sections:

- 1. Compensation (page one);
- 2. Exhibit A Scope of Services; and
- 3. Exhibit C: Budget. All other provisions of this contract agreement shall remain the same:

Amendment 1. Compensation

<u>COMPENSATION.</u> In consideration for CONTRACTOR accomplishing said result, COUNTY agrees to pay contractor as follows:

Total Cost not to exceed \$49,379. Rate based on completion of segments identified in Exhibit A. Contractor shall submit quarterly progress reports and invoices in the following amounts on the following dates: April 3, 1998 (\$8,000); July 1, 1998 (\$8,000); September 20, 1998 (\$26,179); and January 15, 1999 (\$7,200).

Amendment 2. EXHIBIT A <u>SCOPE OF SERVICES</u>

In collaboration with FRCN partners, the Contractor agrees to complete the following segments:

I. Implementation of all Workplan Activities

- a. Ensure that all **workplan** clusters designated within the grant period are implemented within specified time frames.
- b. Assist the FRCN in prioritizing and delegating tasks.
- c. Monitor progress in all cluster areas.
- d. Analyze and evaluate feasibility of designated strategies and make necessary recommendations for modifications as needed.

II. Technical Assistance Support

- a. Coordinate the implementation of the FRCN Technical Assistance Plan.
- b. Follow-up with identified experts and existing resources listed in the technical assistance plan; secure copies of relevant written materials and make them available to FRCN members.
- c. Draft and modify proposed tools, standards, and governance bylaws based on FRCN input.
- d. Coordinate and facilitate three networking events for FRCN participants and interested community members.

III. Liaison to Local Neighborhood and Family-based Initiatives and Collaboratives

- a. Create linkages to existing local and regional collaboratives and gather information regarding relevant opportunities for leveraging resources and consolidating activities; when requested by the FRCN, invite representatives from other family resource centers or county collaboratives to FRCN meetings.
- b. Provide written updates on FRCN workplan activities to designated community groups.

Iv. Monthly FRCN Meetings and Subcommittee Meetings

- a. Develop and disseminate agenda packets for full FRCN meetings and subcommittee meetings.
- b. Ensure that all meetings comply with Brown Act requirements.
- c. Track attendance of participants and keep minutes of meetings.
- d. Serve as liaison to the FRCN Chair and Co-chair.
- e. Attend all FRCN meetings and subcommittee meetings.
- f. Develop master schedule of all FRCN meetings and subcommittee meetings.

V. Grant Administration

- a. Ensure that all reporting requirements of the California Endowment are met on a timely basis; comply with requirements of the California Endowment as specified in the Exhibit D.
- b. Serve as a liaison to the Project Coordinator and Project Evaluator of the joint FRCN and Comprehensive Integrated Services (CIS) Reinvestment Project.
- c. Comply with all County of Santa Cruz reporting requirements.
- d. Communicate with representatives from the California Endowment on an as needed basis.

VI. Family Leadership Conference

- a. Coordinate all aspects of county-wide family leadership conference with FRCN participants. Conference to be held in September 1998.
- b. Goals of conference include: identifying what families believe they need in order to move forward as leaders; identifying potential activities or learning events that families would like to undertake; and identifying ways that families can be involved in FRCN member sites.
- c. Ensure that conference is accessible to Spanish and English speakers. Provide bilingual/bicultural facilitation.
- d. Work with FRCN agencies to ensure that childcare and transportation costs for participating families are covered.
- e. Provide site, meals, and all conference materials.
- f. Ensure that conference is videotaped.
- g. Based on family input during the conference, summarize recommendations and present to the FRCN.


