### REFUND OF 1997-98 PROPERTY TAXES TO SILICON SYSTEMS, INC.

Attached is the claim from Silicon Systems, Inc. for a property tax refund for 1997-98 taxes. The amount of the calculated refund is \$88,590. The claim is in accordance with the December, 1994 agreement with the County of Santa Cruz with reference to ¶5108 of the revenue and taxation code.

Also attached is the calculation of the tax refunds due from the County of Santa Cruz and the City of Santa Cruz Redevelopment Agency (Table 1) and a summary of new full-time manufacturing jobs added according to the conditions set forth in the agreement(Table 2).

The Auditor-Controller's Office has verified the assessed valuation of special equipment with the Assessor's Office, confirmed the taxes have been paid and checked the rebate calculation for accuracy.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board of Supervisors

1. Approve the abatement of General Fund property tax revenue to Silicon Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$88,590,

and

2. Authorize the Auditor-Controller to make the payment and adjust the budgeted property tax accordingly.

Dear Gary,

Silicon Systems, Inc. is requesting that the County rebate a portion of the 1997/1998 property taxes paid by SSi in accordance with the Agreement between the County of Santa Cruz and Silicon Systems, Inc. for the Rebate of Property Taxes.

The amount to be rebated is \$88,590 which represents 50% of the \$177,180 amount calculated by an independent consultant hired by the Redevelopment Agency based on our request to the Agency for the rebate payment due under a related agreement signed with the Agency (see attached Table 1). Also attached (Table 2) is the summary of new full-time manufacturing jobs added at salary levels of greater than \$10.00 per hour per the condition set forth in the agreement.

Please note that Silicon Systems, Inc. has paid in full both installments of the 1997/1998 bill which totals \$1,728,576.98. We would greatly appreciate it if payment was received before the end of September, 1998.
