RE: RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING UNANTICIPATED REVENUE FROM THE HAZARDOUS WASTE ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND

Dear Board Members:

Environmental Health Services on occasion receives a portion of the fines and penalties collected by the State Department of Toxics Substances Control or the District Attorney from local firms found in violation of the laws relative to hazardous waste control. These revenues are maintained by Environmental Health in a Hazardous Waste Enforcement Trust Fund, which, pursuant to the law, can only be used to fund activities of the local Health Officer in enforcement of the Hazardous Waste Control Law.

Environmental Health is proposing to spend \$3500 from the Trust Fund to pay the registration fee for hazardous materials staff to attend the Ammonia Safety and Training Institute, which will be conducted in Watsonville in September. Funds would be taken from the Trust Fund and transferred to the appropriate account in the Environmental Health budget. Attendance by staff at the Institute is needed because EHS assumed enforcement authority for hazardous materials regulation within Watsonville during 1997. There is in excess of one million pounds of ammonia on inventory within the city that EHS must regulate, as well as know how to deal with in the event of an emergency.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board adopt the attached resolution accepting and appropriating unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$3500 for costs associated with the enforcement of the Hazardous Waste Control Law.
