SUBJECT: COUNTY PACKAGING ORDINANCE

Members of the Board:

Chapter 5.46 of the County Code establishes policy goals for businesses in the unincorporated areas of the county to 1) voluntarily eliminate the use of polystyrene foam packaging (PSF) and 2) voluntarily reduce by 50% the amount of non-biodegradable, non-recyclable and non-returnable packaging used. The Code establishes a July 1, 1998, date for compliance with these packaging goals and requires that a report be submitted to your Board within 60 days of July 1, 1998, concerning the degree to which the voluntary goals have been attained.

Chapter 5.46 also provides, based on this evaluation, for a subsequent Code amendment to shift from voluntary compliance to a prohibition on PSF use and a mandated 50% reduction of non-biodegradable, non-recyclable and non-returnable packaging (starting January 1, 1999), if the goals are not met. Public Works has arranged for Ecology Action, as part of their solid waste public awareness services contract with the County, to conduct a survey of businesses in the unincorporated areas of the county on the above packaging issues. The survey is using mail, telephone and on-site visits and the last round of follow-up contacts will be made during the second half of August. A formal report will be ready by late September and based on that schedule we propose to return to your Board on October 6, 1998, with recommendations regarding the ordinance requirements for packaging reduction.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Accept and file this report on voluntary compliance with the packaging reduction goals of Chapter 5.46 of the Santa Cruz County Code.

2. Direct Public Works to return on October 6, 1998, with a report on the packaging reduction survey results and recommendations for further action to achieve the goals of Chapter 5.46.
