Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject emergency relief project are now complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The work, as approved by the California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) under the subject Damage Assessment Form (DAF), allows for the repair of the slipout of one lane and the damaged crib walls which resulted from the February, 1998 storms. Under the Federal Highway Administration's (FHWA) more generous DAF standards for on-system routes, this repair project will provide for construction of a reinforced earth embankment, grading of the slopes, rebuilding the roadway, and the installation of a guardrail.

The engineer's estimate for this work is \$426,000, including contingencies and overhead. Funding for this project has been made available through the FHWA's "On System" road storm repair program administered by CALTRANS, and is included in the approved 1998/99 Road Program.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate, and authorize calling for bids.

- 2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 A.M. on August 25, 1998.
- 3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a tenday period beginning August 9, 1998, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.
