#### Members of the Board:


Attached is Program Supplement Number 0 11 -M to the County-State Agreement No.055936 with an authorizing Board resolution. This agreement provides Federal and State funding reimbursement for preliminary engineering of the Browns Valley Road Bridge at Corralitos Creek. The bridge is currently under design for reconstruction in the summer of 1999. This program supplement allocates a total of \$112,000 to this project.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve Program Supplement No. 0 11-M to the County-State Agreement No. 05-5936.
2. Adopt the attached resolution authorizing agreement between the State of California and the County of Santa Cruz for **funding** preliminary engineering of the Browns Valley at Corralitos Creek Bridge Reconstruction Project.
3. Authorize the Director of Public Works to sign the original and duplicate original of the Program Supplement on behalf of the County.

4. Direct the Clerk of the Board to return the original and duplicate original of Program Supplemental No. 0 11 -M and a copy of the certified Resolution to Hugh G. Brady, Chief of the Office of Local Programs Project Implementation, P.O. Box 942874, MS No. 1, Sacramento, CA 94274-001.





## SPECIAL COVENANTS OR REMARKS

1. All maintenance, involving the physical condition and the operation of the improvements, referred to in Article III MAINTENANCE of the aforementioned Master Agreement will be the responsibility of the Local Agency and shall be performed at regular intervals or as required for efficient operation of the completed improvements.
2. The Local Agency agrees the payment of Federal funds will be limited to the amounts approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2)/Detail Estimate, or its modification (PR-2A) or the FNM-76, and accepts any increases in Local Agency Funds as shown on the Finance or Bid Letter or its modification as prepared by the Office of Local Programs Project Implementation.
3. This agreement supplements the Local Agency-State Master Agreement for Federal-Aid projects, with the understanding that all provisions of the 1991 Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) apply.
4. The Local Agency will advertise, award and administer this project in accordance with the current Local Program Procedures or the new Local Programs Manual, when issued.
5. Whenever the local agency uses a consultant on a cost plus basis, the local agency is required to submit a post audit report covering the allowability of cost payments for each individual consultant or sub-contractor incurring over \$25,000 on the project. The audit report must state the applicable cost principles utilized by the auditor in determining allowable costs as referenced in CFR 49, part 18, Subpart C - 22, Allowable costs.
