PLANNING COMMISSION RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING ADDITION OF POLICY 7.2 1.6 TO THE GENERAL PLAN/LOCAL COASTAL PROGRAM LAND USE PLAN TO ALLOW SANTTARY SEWER CONNECTIONS FOR THE ST. FRANCIS SUBDIVISION AND APPROVAL OF THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION ASSOCIATED WITH SAID AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors directed that an amendment to the General Plan/Local Coastal Program Land Use Plan be processed to allow sanitary sewer connections for the St. Francis Subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has held a duly noticed public hearing and has considered the proposed amendment, and all testimony and evidence received at the public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission finds that the proposed General Plan/Local Coastal Program amendment will be consistent with the policies of the General Plan and Local Coastal Program and is necessary to correct a current and potential future health and safety concern; and

WHEREAS, the Environmental Coordinator issued a Negative Declaration with Mitigations associated with this amendment and the Planning Commission has reviewed the environmental document and finds that the proposed amendment has been processed consistent with applicable provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the County of Santa Cruz environmental guidelines; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Planning Commission recommends the proposed addition of Policy 7.21.6 to the General Plan/Local Coastal Program Land Use Plan and further recommends that the negative declaration be approved by the Board of Supervisors.
