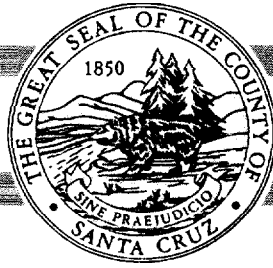



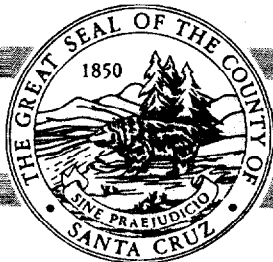
Please let me know if I can provide additional information about my background and experiences that could be useful in the selection process. Regardless of the outcome, thank you for inviting me to apply.

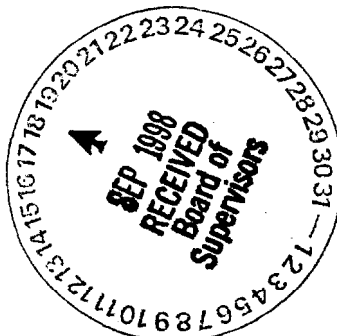

Statement of Qualifications for Resource Conservation District

I am interested in serving on the advisory Board of the Resource Conservation District (RCD) because I believe that it is critical that the citizens of our county work with county staff and other government officials to protect the priceless watershed resources of the Santa Cruz Mountains. The RCD is in the position to help educate our citizenry, advise the Board of Supervisors, and to engage the public in implementing positive change through public participation and cooperation with policy makers,

As a doctoral student in UCSC Environmental Studies program, and a Monterey Bay Regional Studies fellow, my area of interest is the protection of the beneficial uses of water, wildlife habitat, aesthetics, recreation, and conservation of biodiversity provided by local forested watersheds.

I hold both a B. A. and an M. A. in cultural anthropology. While earning my M. A. at Northern Arizona University, I studied comparative economic systems, human evolution, and territorial behavior.

From 1975 until mid 1998, I worked professionally as a computer programmer and technical writer. These skills have proven useful to me since I began working as an environmental advocate.


Since 1993, I have served as a volunteer on the local Sierra Club Forestry Task Force.

Since 1994, I have served as a volunteer director of Citizens for Responsible Forest Management (CRFM), a non-profit organization working to protect the watersheds of the Santa Cruz Mountains.

In 1995-1996, I served as editor of the Sierra Club chapter newsletter, the *Ventana*.

In 1994, I was appointed by the State Board of Forestry to serve on a Forest Practices subcommittee to address the problems of exemption logging. The subcommittee recommended key changes, which were eventually adopted by the Board of Forestry. Most significantly, counties regained control of these small operations.

In 1997, I was appointed by the County Board of Supervisors to the Timber Technical Advisory Committee for the purpose of addressing problems associated with increased logging in our county. I served on that committee for its duration.

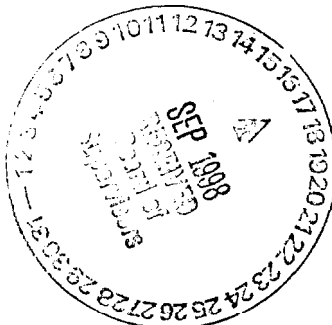

3. **Alternate** : Ken Tell


