Subject: Schedule a public hearing to consider the proposal to amend Commercial Development Permit No. 96-0772 by operating a teen residential care facility with a reduction in the permitted number of youth to 20 full-time residential occupants and 10 day-time participants and a reduction in number of staff to 10. The amendment maintains the existing 5,657 square foot community house containing 10 bedrooms, kitchen, dining room, and living rooms and a 2,588 square foot administrative office building. The amendment retains the historic use of the 7 existing cottages as rental units. Requires an amendment to Commercial Development Permit 96-0772. Property located on the north side of Freedom Boulevard, about 0.25 miles east of the intersection with Corralitos Road.

Members of the Board:

On June 24, 1998 Your Board approved an application by Above the Line to operate a residential care facility to house homeless teens. Since your approval, the program concept has been changed which requires an amendment to Commercial Development Permit 96-0772. Section 18.10.134 of the County Code requires amendments to approved applications to be processed by the original approving body, which was the Board of Supervisors.

It is therefore, RECOMMENDED, that your Board schedule a public hearing to consider this application on Tuesday November 24, 1998, for the afternoon agenda starting at 1:30 p.m
