### Traffic Impact Reduction Program

Dear Members of the Board:

In November of 1997, the Agency provided your Board with a report on a proposed Traffic Impact Reduction Program. The report outlined a general approach for developing a strategy to reduce the problems associated with traffic speeds and volumes in local neighborhoods. The next step in program implementation was to begin discussions with Public Works to design a pilot project for the Live Oak and Soquel communities. However, as we reported to your Board in April of this past year, the Simpkins Family Swim Center and Live Oak Community Center project has continued to require a great deal of the Agency's time. As a result, we have not been able to proceed with development of a Traffic Impact Reduction Program as planned. With the recent addition of staff to the Agency and reassignment of project responsibilities, we anticipate being able to initiate discussions with Public Works early next year.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board, as the Board of Directors for the Redevelopment Agency, direct the Redevelopment Agency, in consultation with the Department of Public Works, to develop recommendations for implementing a Traffic Impact Reduction Program in Live Oak and Soquel and to report back with this information on March 23, 1999.


