### SUBJECT: PROPOSED NEW STOP SIGNS

Members of the Board:

The Department of Public Works is recommending to your Board the installation of several new stop signs in the La Selva Beach, Aptos and Soquel areas. Location maps are attached for each proposed stop sign location.

The first stop sign is proposed at the Breve Avenue approach to Playa Boulevard in the La Selva Beach area. The stop sign meets State Traffic Manual warrants and is supported by the La Selva Beach Homeowners Association.


The second proposed stop sign location would provide for multiway stop signs at the La Selva Drive/Robak Drive and Mar Monte Avenue intersection. Currently, this intersection has stop signs at the La Selva Drive and Robak Drive approaches. Although the intersection does not meet volume warrants from the State Traffic Manual, the proposed addition of stop signs will provide for improved operations at the intersection, due to the existing geometrics at the intersection.

The third proposed stop sign location would provide multiway stops at the Hilltop Road and Cornwell Road/Valera Drive intersection. Your Board required the developer of the Tan Heights Subdivision, as a permit condition, to install multiway stop signs at the intersection. In order to proceed with the installation, the County Codes must be revised to move forward with the installation of the stop signs.

The fourth stop sign proposed is to convert a yield condition to a stop condition at the northbound Rio Del Mar Boulevard right turn approach to Clubhouse Drive. This intersection currently meets multiway stop signs and is considered an upgrade in improving operations at the intersection.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt the attached Ordinance in concept for the installation of new stop signs in the La Selva Beach, Aptos and Soquel areas, and place the Ordinance on the next available agenda for final adoption.



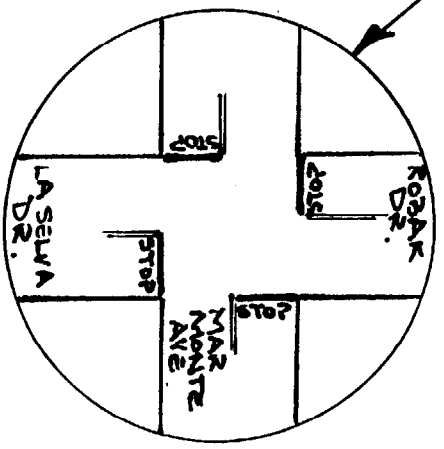
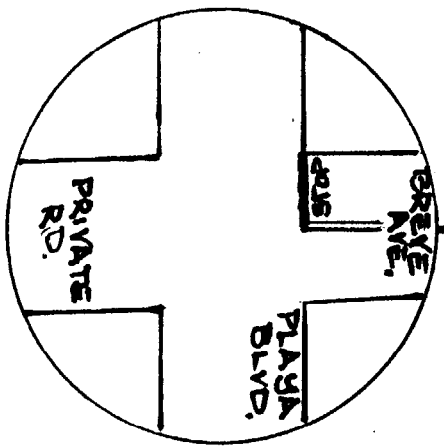
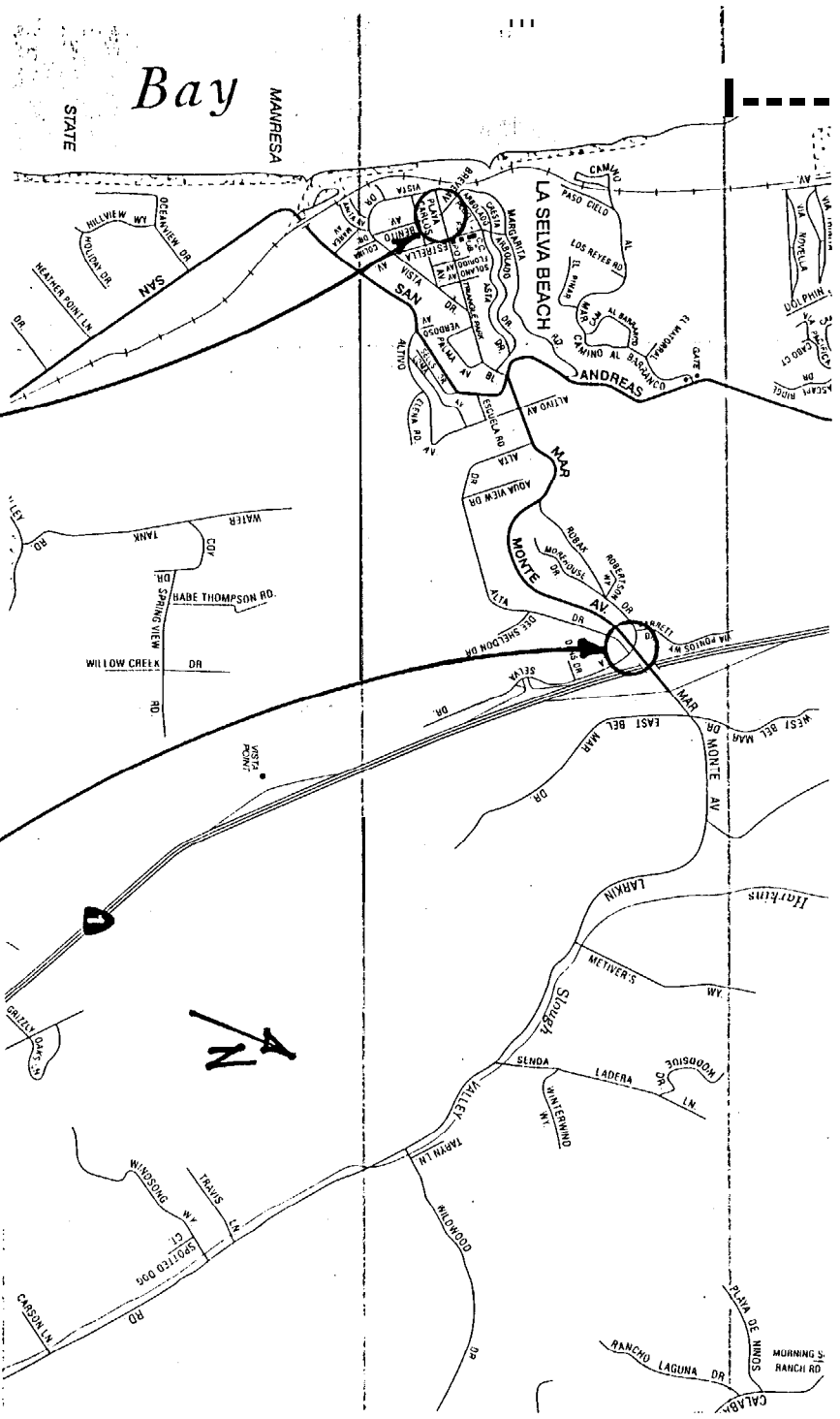
LOCATION MAP
