I have been following bills **from** both houses and advising my Chapter residents what is recommended by our Legal Counsel in Sacramento. I have had an arrangement with Senator **Mello** and Assemblyman **Farr** and now have the same arrangement with Senator McPherson and Assemblyman Fred Keeley to allow our people to place a phone call indicating lhow they wish to have a vote made on various bills.
