My application for the Mobile Home Commission is attached.

Having lived in Vista Del Lago Mobile Home Park since 1975 I have lived thru some amazing changes. The strangle hold the Park Owners have over the residents is actually becoming life threatening to some older residents.

I have been following bills **from** both houses and advising my Chapter residents what is recommended by our Legal Counsel in Sacramento. I have had an arrangement with Senator **Mello** and Assemblyman **Farr** and now have the same arrangement with Senator McPherson and Assemblyman Fred Keeley to allow our people to place a phone call indicating how they wish to have a vote made on various bills.

When I first began dealing with legislation there were very few bills each year, now we are having so many. One bill has just gone thru two full years of amendments and is now going to have to get a new number and I will have to start all over again as it goes thru the various committees. Perhaps it will be written better this time and we will get a bill that is fair to residents.
