SUBJECT: SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS ON SOQUEL DRIVE AT TWIN PALMS DRIVE
MINOR LAND DIVISION 92-0774, AMARANTE (FORMERLY COVELL)


Roadside improvements along Soquel Drive were recently constructed as part of the subject minor land division in accordance with corridor improvement plans produced in 1992 by the County's consultant. The location of the roadside improvements (see attached map) were appropriate for the four-lane configuration of Soquel Drive existing at the time the final plans for the minor land division were originally reviewed and tentatively approved in 1993. As a result of the two State-authorized 2-year tentative map extensions, the land division project lay dormant for nearly six years after having undergone the plan review and approval process, awaiting only the subdivider's action to proceed to signoff and parcel map recordation.

A new owner of the project finally took the actions necessary to, proceed to completion earlier this year, recorded the map, and constructed the improvements as a result. These new minor land division improvements, however, did not take into account last year's restriping of Soquel Drive for a five-lane configuration. Although the paved width of Soquel Drive is still sufficient to provide five travel lanes and two bike lanes, restriping at this point would not be cost-effective or recommended. While the reconstruction of this short segment of curb, gutter, and sidewalk could be included in a planned future County roadside improvement project on Soquel Drive, Public Works believes that it would be preferable to accomplish the reconstruction as soon as possible so as to better accommodate bicycle traffic, rather than wait for inclusion in that project.

There is surplus revenue available in the Aptos Roadside Improvement Fund as a result of recent development in the area that could be used for this reconstruction work. Public Works would recommend that \$20,000 be allocated for this purpose.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors adopt Resolution Accepting Unanticipated Revenue in the amount of \$20,000 from the Aptos Roadside Improvement Fund to reconstruct this segment of curb, gutter, and sidewalk through a purchase order contract.


