COMMUNI'IY ACCESS GRANT

Dear Members of the Board:

In June of 1988, the Santa Cruz County department of Parks, Open Space and Cultural Services (County Parks), applied for a \$20,000 Community ACCESS Hub Grant from the Community Foundation of Santa Cruz County. We are proud to **say that** County Parks was one of three agencies in Santa Cruz County awarded the grant. These grants are funded by the James Irvine Foundation for the purpose of improving Santa Cruz County's youth development programs, and for encouraging the involvement of 1 l- 14 year olds in the planning and implementation process.

In the grant application, County Parks proposed a new middle school recreation program for youth who live in the Live Oak Community. Specifically, our ACCESS project aims to improve youth development opportunities for middle school age youth in Live Oak; particular-y during extended school breaks. The program will work closely with youth from Shoreline Middle School in the Live Oak School District. A significant component of this program is that teens are involved throughout the process. We feel that our program will be well attended due to the fact that we will be working side-by-side with teens to help them incorporate their ideas into a program for youngsters of their own age.

The Parks Department's grant proposal included matching funds of \$12,275, which was included in the approved 1998-99 budget. The proposal also specified creating the position of a Teen Coordinator to work with current recreation staff to implement this new program. This will be an additional position in the Parks Department, and therefore will need the approval of your Board. The current grant from the James Irvine Foundation allows us to receive the same level of funding for **one** additional year. Given the funding situation of the ACCESS Grant, we would like to request that your Board approve the addition of a new full-time permanent Recreation Coordinator with a 2-year limited term appointment.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board:

- 1. Adopt a resolution accepting unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$20,000, and establish appropriations as specified in the resolution.
- 2. Approve a 2-year limited term appointment (January 1, 1999 December 3 1, 2000) of a Recreation Coordinator-Teens, in the Parks Department.
