Per your request, following are the proposed fee amounts and description of services provided by the Work Release Program of the Santa Cruz County Sheriffs Department.

The Work Release Program is an alternative sentencing program administered under the California Penal Code Section 4024.2. The program provides an opportunity for the minimum classification sentenced inmate to serve their jail sentence living out of custody and working an 8 hour day at an assigned worksite weekly.

Since the inception of this program, to my knowledge, the fees have remained the same: \$50 enrollment fee and \$4 per day for Workers Compensation insurance. The proposed fee is the addition of a \$40 rescheduling fee. This fee would be charged in the event that a Work Release inmate were to miss a day. Upon the rescheduling of their sentence, we would charge a \$40 per rescheduling the missed day(s).

The process for rescheduling missed days is the same as the application and assignment process. The computer entries and paperwork are extensive and time consuming. The fee would pay for the officer time spent on this process, the paperwork and computer work generated and would additionally deter inmates from unnecessary absences.

Recent research reflects that the average rescheduling fees are ranging from \$25 - \$80. Contra Costa, Riverside, San Bernardino, and Kern Counties include such a fee in their program. Per diem fees range from \$3.50 - \$25. Enrollment fees range from \$110-20.
