NORTH COAST BEACHES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Dear Members of the Board:

On October 16, 1990, your Board established the North Coast Beaches Advisory Committee (NCBAC), with the purpose of advising the Board on all matters related to the management of the County's north coast beaches and the implementation of the North Coast Beaches Master Plan.

The North Coast Beaches Master Plan addresses coastal access issues at eight (8) north County Beaches: Laguna Creek Beach, Yellowbanks Beach, Bonny Doon Beach, Panther Beach, Davenport Beach and Bluffs, Davenport Landing Beach, Scott Creek Beach, and Greyhound Rock Beach. All eight beaches were designated primary public access points in the 1994 County General Plan.

Funding remains available to improve public access and provide for natural resource protection at Scott Creek Beach. The NCBAC continues to provide guidance and support to the County in our effort to implement the North Coast Beaches Master Plan.

The term of the Committee expires December 31, 1998; however, at the October 19, 1998, NCBAC meeting, Committee members, acting as a Committee For the Whole, requested that your Board extend the term of the Committee one (I) year so that the Committee may continue its role in overseeing the implementation and management of the North Coast Beaches Master Plan. Phone calls were made to absent Committee members, and a term extension of one year was overwhelmingly supported.

The County Parks Department requests that your Board reappoint the individuals named herein as representatives of the eleven (1 I) organizations named in Resolution #584-90, forming the North Coast Beaches Advisory Committee.

On the motion of Supervisor Belgard duly seconded by Supervisor Beautz the following resolution is adopted:

RESOLUTION TO EXTEND THE TERM OF THE SANTA CRUZ COUNTY NORTH COAST BEACHES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Santa Cruz County North Coast is a unique and important part of Santa Cruz County; and

WHEREAS, the North Coast possesses many areas of extreme environmental sensitivity, which need protection and preservation; and


WHEREAS, the North Coast also provides unparalleled recreation opportunities, particularly on its many beaches; and

WHEREAS, the North Coast is also an area which maintains significant agricultural production, on coastal agricultural lands, and has significant residential development in certain areas, including the Davenport landing area, and Town of Davenport, and the Coast Road area: and

WHEREAS, the proper and appropriate management and protection of the North Coast, and the North Coast Beaches, is of great importance to the citizens of Santa Cruz County, including particularly North Coast and Bonny Doon residents, North Coasts agricultural owners and farmers, workers, and residents in the Town of Davenport, and the board sailors, hand gliders, surfers, naturalist, and beach-goers who utilize the beaches of the North Coast for recreation purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Santa Cruz County wishes to implement the North Coast Beaches Master Plan, to ensure the preservation and protection of areas of significant environmental value; to protect agricultural land and agricultural uses; to maximize recreational areas and recreational opportunities; and to provide necessary safety and public health protection for the residents, workers, and others who live on or who visit the North Coast; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, by Resolution #584-90 established the North Coast Beaches Advisory Committee to advise the Board on all matters relating the management of the County's North Coast Beaches, and particularly with respect to the implementation of any portion of the North Coast Beaches Master plan; and



WHEREAS, the term of the North Coast Beaches Advisory Committee is scheduled to expire on December 31, 1998.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz to extend the term of the North Coast Beaches Advisory Committee to December 31, 1999, or until dissolved by resolution of the Board of Supervisors, whichever occurs first. The Committee's term shall be renewable only by resolution of the Board of Supervisors specifying a new termination date.
