Approve Resolution Accepting and Appropriating Unanticipated Revenue from Board of Corrections for Probation Standards and Training for Corrections Program, as Recommended by the Chief Probation Officer

Dear Board Members:

The State Board of Corrections has released its final allocation of funds for the Probation Department's Standards and Training for Corrections Program for FY 1998-99. The allocation is revised from \$28,350 to \$47,000, an increase of \$18,650 for the current fiscal year. This increase includes a one-time only specific expenditure approval in the amount of \$3,000 for the purchase of a computer management system to be used in support of the Probation Department's annual staff training plan and program.

The Board of Corrections provides funds to partially offset the cost of training Probation staff as required by the Standards and Training for Corrections Program under SB 924. The Probation Department submits an annual training plan which is the basis for the allocation.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board accept unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$18,650 in Probation Index 574000, approve the fixed asset purchase of one personal computer system, and appropriate as detailed on the attached AUD 60.

In response to our request dated September 4, 1998, your agency submitted an "Annual Training Plan Modification and Worksheet" which contained updated figures for the number and type of STC eligible positions currently budgeted for your department. Your-Fiscal Year 1998-99 Annual Training Plan has been amended to conform'to the data contained in your worksheet. Your department's Fiscal Year 1998-99 fiscal allotment has been amended from \$28,950.00 to \$47,000.00, a difference of \$18,050.00 and includes the state's augmentation to its Corrections Training Fund. 

An important point pertains to a ONE TIME ONLY APPROVAL OF A SPECIFIC EXPENDITURE for FY 1998-99. Participating departments are authorized to spend a maximum of \$3,000 of their STC allocation for the purchase of a computer management system. This computer is to be used for the implementation and management of the STC Program within your department. There is one condition for the approval of this expenditure and that is that the computer system must have internet capabilities and is used for connecting to the Board of Corrections' web site, to obtain and send critical information pertaining to the implementation of the STC Program.
