SUBJECT: ADDITION OF A .75 FTE PARK MAINTENANCE WORKER I/II

Dear Members of the Board:

The Simpkins Family Swim Center and Live Oak Community Center became operational November 16, 1998. Since then, the pools, indoor and outdoor shower/locker rooms, and community center components have been used throughout the day and evening by many individuals and community groups.

The original estimates for the maintenance of the facility were limited to a 1.0 FTE Building Maintenance Worker III, who serves as the lead maintenance and operations staff person at the center. We also had an additional \$25709.00 set aside in extra help funds to assist in the maintenance and operation of the pools, community center and ancillary facilities. After further analysis of the requirements to maintain a facility that is open up to fifteen hours per day, we are proposing to convert the extra help funds into a 0.75 FTE permanent maintenance worker.

Current pool operations staff, both permanent and temporary, have received extensive training over the past eight weeks on chemical handling, water chemistry, and general building maintenance operations specific to this center. The variety of job duties and the specialized training related to pool operations and community center maintenance make it more cost effective to train staff who are permanent and can continue to refine their skills and abilities to the benefit of the Department and the County.

We are requesting the use of Departmental Extra-Help appropriations to fund an additional 0.75 FTE PMWI/II, who will be assigned to the Simpkins Family Swim Center. Due to the extensive operational hours and in depth training required for this position, a permanent employee is the most efficient use of County funds. Sufficient funding for this position is available within the current Simpkins Family Swim Center budget, and there will be no additional cost to the County.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board approve the addition of a 0.75 FTE PMWI/II for the Parks, Open Space and Cultural Services Department; and authorize the transfer of funds for the balance of the fiscal year.
