REQUEST TO ADVERTISE BONNY DOON REPLACEMENT FIRE STATION PROJECT

Dear Members of the Board:

Plans and specifications for the Bonny Doon Replacement Fire Station project have been prepared by the County of Santa Cruz General Services Department and Teall Messer, Architect, working in conjunction with the Bonny Doon volunteer company and CDF/County Fire staff. All environmental reviews have been completed and the plans approved.

This project was previously bid and all bids were rejected since the low bid significantly exceeded available funds. Subsequent to the previous bid, the scope of work has been reduced and various items of work are being included as add alternates in an attempt to structure a bid package which will come in within available funding limitations.

These changes were developed with the concurrence of the Bonny Doon volunteer company who have also indicated a willingness to work with the community and locate volunteer efforts to complete various items of work which were eliminated from the bid package. Working with the community in this manner it is expected that we will be able to construct a fire station including all the amenities which are important to serve the community needs.

Funds for this project are budgeted in the plant budget index 194020, subobject 6610, for the work. The cost for construction of the items included in the base bid for this project is estimated at \$347,000.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board take the following actions.

- 1. Approve plans and specifications on file with the Clerk of the Board for the Bonny Doon Replacement Fire Station project; and
- 2. Direct the General Services Department to advertise for bids; and
- 3. Set the bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on January 26, 1999
