

## ALCOHOL AND DRUG ABUSE COMMISSION 1998 ANNUAL REPORT

### Role of the Commission

To advise the Board of Supervisors and the Alcohol and Drug Program Administrator on alcohol and drug abuse issues through participation in the planning process, development of the goals and policies of the County Alcohol and Drug Program, education of the public about alcohol and drug abuse problems and services, advocacy on alcohol and drug-related legislative issues, review of alcohol and drug services provided by the County to ensure quality, and review of the procedures used to ensure citizen involvement in alcohol and drug abuse program policies and procedures.

### Meeting Dates, Time and Location

Second Monday of each month at 5:00 p.m. at rotating locations in North, South and Mid-County.

### Commission Structure

Each Supervisor appoints three members who represent the Supervisor's district. During 1998, the Chairperson was Argelia Flores and the Vice Chairperson was Jeff Roth. Other commissioners are listed on the attached attendance roster.

### Commission Staff

The Health Services Agency Alcohol and Drug Program provides staff support to the Commission, including preparation of meeting minutes and some correspondence.

### Accomplishments - 1998

- Developed A.A./N.A. meetings in the Watsonville area targeting youth.
- Supported AB 2029 (Keeley). Sent letter of support to Assemblymember Keeley, Senator McPherson and to the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors related to adults buying alcohol for underage persons.
- Supported Cinco De Mayo campaign.
- An ADAC retreat developed mission, vision and role of Commission. Developed goals identifying opportunities, priorities and follow-up on monitoring evaluations.
- An ADAC retreat on values clarification assisted ADAC to be more committed and do a better job.

- Honored Ron Skidmore for outstanding service for over 15 years in the alcohol and drug field.
- Supported the 1998 - 1999 Prevention Plan. The ADAC requested to be informed ahead of time in order to review any future plan.
- Issued a Proclamation honoring Robert E. Neff in his work in the alcohol and drug field and others who work in the field.
- Reviewed Alcohol/Drug and Mental Health Consolidation . ADAC is requesting to be closely informed in order to monitor the process to insure services to the public are not compromised.
- Supported Santa Cruz youth treatment services.

#### Future Goals

- Monitor contract service providers for culturally appropriate services and implement the goals of the Cultural Competence Framework related to diversity.
- Continue with the Adopt-a-Provider Program.
- Be an active participant in the implementation of Proposition 10.
- Monitor the development of adolescent alcohol and drug treatment services.
- Monitor the consolidation of alcohol and drug and mental health administration to ensure that alcohol and drug services are maintained or enhanced.
- ADAC members will continue to improve their working relationships with the individual members of the Board of Supervisors by updating them as needed.

#### Recommendations

- The Commission recommends that the Board of Supervisors make timely appointments to fill vacant Commission seats.
