

Statement of Qualifications:

As founder and executive director of the Valley Resource Center for the past eleven years, I, with a dedicated staff, established the only Family Resource Center in Santa Cruz County that provides a continuum of services from birth to death. I have actively participated in the many committees, advisory groups and commissions who have been working on long term **planning** for children and their families for the past 10 years. I served on the original **committee** to establish the criteria for Family Preservation Family Support Programs (FPSP) as well as:

Prior to my time spent in bringing a broad range of social services to the San Lorenzo Valley and identifying resources existing in our own community, I established the Valley Emergency Preparedness Network, currently called Mountain Neighbors Network, and participated in all the disaster recovery efforts since 1974.

From 1975 -1978, I served on the Santa Cruz County Planning Commission through which I became acquainted with the varied and distinct areas and cultures of the County. At the same time, I participated in the founding of the Environmental Council of Santa Cruz, the Resource Defense Fund, the Valley Women's Club, Save San Lorenzo River Association and Valley Citizens for Clean Water.

Through all these efforts, I gained an incredible understanding of our county as well as developing contacts with a broad range of people, representing valuable resources in our larger community.
