Included in the 1998/99 Redevelopment Agency budget are funds for the construction of the subject Harper Court Pedestrian Bridge and Pathway improvements.



The total engineer's estimate for this project is \$307,000 including contingencies and administration. **Sufficient** funds are available for this project.

2. Set bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on March 9, 1999.

3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a "Notice to Contractors" for a 10-day period beginning February 13, 1999, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.




Bids are required for the entire work.
