CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION, INTERVENTION AND TREATMENT (CAPIT) AND FAMILY PRESERVATION AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS (FPSP): FUNDING AUGMENTATIONS AND CONTRACT AMENDMENTS

Dear Members of the Board:

As you are aware, the Human Resources Agency (HRA) administers several federal and state funding streams that are utilized to contract for community-based services to children and families. Two of these funding streams are Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment (CAPIT) and Family Preservation and Support Programs (FPSP). HRA has recently been informed by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) that Santa Cruz County's allocations for CAPIT and FPSP have received mid-year augmentations. The Children's Network, which annually makes recommendations to your Board for the use of these funding streams, has developed recommendations for utilization of the augmented funds. The purpose of this letter is to request your Board's approval to accept and appropriate the unanticipated revenue, as well as your approval of contract amendments with community-based service providers to provide additional CAPIT and FPSP services.

CAPIT Augmentation

Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention and Treatment (CAPIT) services are funded by a three-year grant from CDSS to the County. The County's current allocation is \$98,371 per year, and the funds are subcontracted to the Parents Center, to provide individual, family, and group counseling, parenting education, family outreach services, and community education to schools, parent organizations, businesses, child care providers and other community groups.

As a result of the passage of AB 2779, the State has augmented Counties' CAPIT allocations for FY 98/99, and adopted new guidelines for the CAPIT program which require counties to give priority to prevention services to families with children ages 0 to 5. The State is particularly encouraging services that include home visiting based on research-based models of best practices. The amount of augmentation funds allocated to Santa Cruz County for FY 98/99 is \$50,414. On October 28, 1998, the Children's Network Cabinet developed recommendations for

utilization of these additional CAPIT funds. The Children's Network recommends that the funds be utilized to expand the Healthy Families Collaborative, an intensive home visiting program that is currently operated by the Parents Center, Valley Resource Center, Farnilia Center, and Walnut Avenue Women's Center. The collaborative was initiated with funding from Together for Youth, and a need for additional service capacity has been identified. The home visiting services provided by the Healthy Families Collaborative are very consistent with the new CAPIT guidelines, which emphasize home visiting and other prevention services, and HRA concurs with the Children's Network recommendation.

On November 17, 1998, HRA submitted the Children's Network recommendation for utilization of the augmentation funds to CDSS for approval. On December 2, 1998, CDSS informed HRA that the proposed use of the funds was approved. The State has prepared an amendment to its CAPIT revenue agreement with HRA, which is attached for your approval. The amendment increases the revenue agreement by \$50,414, and reduces the term of the agreement from three years to two years (expiring on June 30, 1999), so that the State can initiate a new agreement which incorporates the new CAPIT legislative guidelines to begin on July 1, 1999. Beginning in FY 99/00, the augmentation funds will be rolled into the County's general CAPIT allocation, increasing the allocation to \$148,785.

In order to provide the CAPIT augmentation funds to the Healthy Families Collaborative, HRA has prepared an amendment to its CAPIT agreement with the Parents Center, which serves as the collaborative's fiscal agent. As indicated in the contract amendment, the augmented funds will enable the Healthy Families Collaborative to provide services to 162 unduplicated clients, including 1,320 hours of home visiting to families, three parenting classes, and "Together in the Park" workshops for parents and their children.

At this time, it is necessary to accept and appropriate the additional CAPIT revenue, and to approve the attached amendment adding \$50,414 to the CDSS revenue agreement as well as the amendment adding the same amount to HRA's contract with the Parents Center.

FPSP Augmentation

As you will recall, the 1993 Federal Family Preservation and Support Act offers communities across the country an opportunity to extend integrated service delivery systems in order to strengthen families and improve outcomes for children. Over a five year period, the County of Santa Cruz is receiving approximately \$500,000 to develop, expand, and evaluate Family Preservation and Support Program (FPSP) services to at-risk families. On October 6, 1998, your Board approved the distribution of Santa Cruz County's FPSP funds for Federal Fiscal Year 1998/99 in the amount of \$138,063, allocating a portion of the funds to the Family Resource Center Network (FRCN) and awarding contracts for FPSP activities to the Valley Resource Center, Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center, the Youth Resources Bank, and the Foundation of California State University, Monterey Bay.

Funding Augmentation and Contract Amendments

In October 1998, HRA was informed by CDSS that Santa Cruz County's FPSP allocation for Federal Fiscal Year 1998/99 was being augmented by \$22,909, increasing our County's annual allocation from \$138,063 to \$160,972. On October 28, 1998, the Children's Network Cabinet developed recommendations for the utilization of the additional \$22,909. Of this amount, the Children's Network recommends: (1) that \$1,375 be added to HRA's contract with Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center to provide bilingual parenting resource information to parents of newborns throughout Santa Cruz County; (2) that \$10,767 be added to HRA's contract with Youth Resources Bank to provide additional treatment and intervention services for families with an open Child Protective Services case; and (3) that the remaining \$10,767 be used in conjunction with grant funds from the California Endowment, in order to continue developing a network of 15 community-based family resource centers. These funds will be utilized by the Family Resource Center Network to provide direct assistance to families in order to enable them to participate in family leadership activities at participating family resource centers.

The \$22,909 FPSP augmentation must be utilized by September 30, 1999, the end of the Federal Fiscal Year. Of this amount, \$16,839 will be expended during the County's FY 98/99 (by June 30, 1999) and the remaining \$6,070 will be expended in the first quarter of FY 99/00. In addition to accepting \$50,414 in CAPIT revenue and approving the associated CAPIT amendments, at this time it is necessary to accept and appropriate \$16,839 in FPSP revenue, and to approve the attached contract amendments adding \$1,375 to HRA's contract with Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center and \$10,767 to HRA's contract with the Youth Resources Bank.

IT IS THEREFORE RECOMMENDED that your Board:

- 1. Approve the attached resolution accepting unanticipated revenue in the amount of \$67,253 and appropriate these funds as described in the attached AUD 60;
- 2. Approve the attached amendment adding \$50,414 to the California Department of Social Services revenue agreement with the County; and
- 3. Approve the attached amendments adding \$50,414 to HRA's agreement with the Parents Center, \$1,375 to HRA's agreement with Food and Nutrition Services/Family Health Education Center, and \$10,767 to HRA's agreement with the Youth Resources Bank.

This agreement for the general provision of Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention, & Treatment (CAPIT 1733) Grant is amended follows:

Grantee shall carry out the intent of the legislature set forth by AB 2779 Chaptered 8/21/98 and detailed in the Office of Child Abuse Prevention letter of August 28, 1998, REQUIREMENT FOR RECEIVING INCREASED FUNDING FOR CAPIT GRANTS.

L SCOPE **OF** WORK

The attached Exhibit A (A-I) consisting of one page and entitled "Scope of Work" replaces Exhibit A and is made part hereof by this reference. This Scope of Work covers the revised period July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1999.

IL SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Original Grant TERMS AND CONDITIONS Section VIII shall be supplemented to include the attached Exhibit C (A-I) consisting of one page and entitled "Special Provisions". The Special Provisions cover the revised period July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1999.

III. BUDGET

The attached Exhibit B (A-I) consisting of one page and entitled "Budget" replaces Exhibit B and is part hereof by this reference. This Budget covers the revised period July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1999. Revised period eliminates final year budget allocation of Original Grant.

IV. TERMS

The terms of this agreement covers the period July 1, 1997 through June 30, 1999 and SUPERCEDES all other previous terms.

The original grant amount of \$196,742.00 is hereby increased in the amount of \$50,414.00 for a grant total not to exceed \$247,156.00.

VI. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHALL REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

The provisions on the reverse side hereof constitute a part of this agreement. IN **WITNESS WHEREOF**, this agreement has been executed by the parties hereto, upon the date first above written.

VIII. SPECIAL **PROVISIONS**

- 1. The grantee shall ensure that revenues shall be allocated through the use of an accountable process that utilizes a multidisciplinary approach, particularly including strengthening child abuse councils and in a manner consistent with a county expenditure plan for Child Abuse Prevention, Intervention, and Treatment program revenues. The grantee's plan shall explain how services funded under this article are coordinated with the array of services available in the county and are based on unmet needs. Priority shall be given to prevention programs through nonprofit agencies, including, where appropriate, programs that identify and provide services to isolated families, particularly those with children five years of age or younger, high quality home visiting programs based on research-based models of best practices, and services to child victims of crime. The Office of Child Abuse Prevention shall review and approve these plans prior to authorizing county expenditure of funds. The Office of Child Abuse Prevention shall require counties to submit annual reports on program services.
- 2. Grantee with provider contracts in effect as of June 30, 1998 may continue those contracts. During the 1998-99 state fiscal year, if a county qualifies to receive an augmentation of funds, counties may augment existing provider contracts without competitive bids.
- 3. **Grantee** agrees to provide services in accordance with the OCAP approved **CAPIT** c o u n t y p 1 a n

AMENDMENT #1 TO INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR AGREEMENT #80778 CAPIT AGREEMENT

The County of Santa Cruz, by and through the Human Resources Agency, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY" and Parents Center, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR" hereby amend contract number 70778 which provides services from July 1, 1997 through June 30, 2000. The purpose of this amendment is to provide an augmentation in the amount of \$50,414 (for FY 98/99 only), and thereby to modify the total contract amount, budget, and scope of work. The provisions of this Amendment shall be effective fi-om December 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999. All other provisions of said contract shall remain the same.

- (A) Paragraph 2A is amended to read:
- A. In consideration of services rendered, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR on the basis of appropriate claims submitted to the Human Resources Agency in accordance with Exhibit "B" ("Budget"), incorporated herein by reference, to be submitted by CONTRACTOR to COUNTY prior to the release of any payments under this Agreement. In no event shall the maximum payment made by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR for basic CAPIT services under this Agreement exceed the sum of \$98,371 annually for the period of July 1, 1997 through June 30, 2000. However, for the period of December 1 1998 through June 30, 1999, COUNTY shall pay CONTRACTOR for additional CAPIT Augmentation services. In no event shall the maximum payment made by COUNTY to CONTRACTOR for CAPIT Augmentation services under this Agreement exeed the sum of \$50.414 for the period of December 1, 1998 through June 30, 1999.
- (B) Exhibit "A" ("PROGRAM RESONSIBILITIES AND FUNCTIONS" is amended as follows:

Item 5 is added to read:

- Provide the following CAPIT Augmentation services through the "Healthy Families Collaborative" (a collaboration with the Valley Resource Center, Familia Center, and Walnut Avenue Women's Center):
 - Home visiting and parenting services to families with children aged 0 to 5 who are identified as being at risk of child abuse, neglect, or other serious parenting problems. Services will be provided to 162 unduplicated clients, including:
 - 1320 hours of home visiting to families b.
 - Three additional parenting classes C.
 - Parent/Child "Together in the Park" workshops d.
 - Quarterly activity reports to the County will include descriptions of these activities and of the program and fiscal agreements between Parents Center and its subcontractors.
- (C) Exhibit "B" ("BUDGET") is amended as attached.

The purpose of this amendment is to provide an augmentation in the amount of \$10,767. The provisions of this Amendment shall be effective from February 15, 1999 through September 30, 1999. All other provisions of said contract shall remain the same.
