SUBJECT: 1998/99 TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT (TDA)
ARTICLE 8 PROJECT ALLOCATION CLAIM

Members of the Board:

The Department of Public Works has received a January 11, 1999, letter from the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission regarding the 1998/99 Transportation Development Act (TDA) Article 8 funding allocation. In response to a funding demand, our department is making recommendations to your Board to revise the TDA allocation to provide additional funding for the Holohan Road Bike Lane Project, Phase I. The department is recommending the funding revisions for this project because it fulfills a community demand for bicycle commuters and local elementary students, provides for improved roadway operations, and is a high-priority project for the Santa Cruz County Regional Transportation Commission Bike Committee. The project limits are from the Highway 152 and Holohan Road intersection to the east near the Grimmer Road intersection.

The proposed revisions in TDA funding include the reallocation of \$15,000 in **Bikeway** Conflict funding to the Holohan Road Bike Lane Project. Staff from the Department of Public Works has met with the Bike Committee and they support this proposed transfer of funding. In addition, \$17,142.13 of unallocated TDA funding would be allocated to the Holohan Road Bike Lane Project. The funding allocations for the remaining County projects would remain unchanged in the 1998/99 TDA budget.


It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the reallocation of \$15,000 of TDA Article 8 funding for the **Bikeway Conflict** Project to the Holohan Road Bike Lane Project.

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2. Adopt the attached resolution accepting unanticipated TDA funding in the amount of \$17,142.13 and allocate this amount to the Holohan Road Bike Lane Project.



fiscal year budget of the County; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Sections 29130(c), 29064(b), such
