As founder and executive director of the Valley Resource Center for the past eleven years, I, with a dedicated staff, established the only Family Resource Center in Santa Cruz County that provides a continuum of services from birth to death. I have actively participated in the many committees, advisory groups and commissions who have been working on long term planning for children and their families for the past 10 years. 
