of claimants' driveway which has been buried in silt and sand 1 and which has washed out within the past year. 2 Any and all public employees involved in the negligent and 3 intentional conduct were acting within the course and scope of 4 their employment and under the direction of the County of Santa 5 Cruz at the time of the negligent and intentional conduct which 6 is the subject of this claim. 7 The amount claimed, as of the date of presentation of this 8 claim, is computed as follows: 9 Scraping approximately 200 feet of driveway and making 10 \$ 1,000; repairs: 11 Re-contouring the first 25 feet of the driveway south of 12 the existing culvert to create a slope toward the existing 13 county drainage ditch : \$1,000; 14 Resurfacing 200' x 10' driveway with oil and screenings @ 15 \$.75/square foot: \$1,500; 16 Addition of a sand trap to the county drainage ditch 17 upslope from the driveway to catch silt, sand, mud and other 18 run-off to avoid clogging the driveway culvert: 19 \$1,500.
