Santa Cruz County Women's Commission Statement of Qualifications, Sandra L. Brown

My interest in serving on the Santa Cruz County Women's Commission stems from my work over the past five years addressing issues affecting low-income women. My work at the University and in the community has focused on the particular challenges that low-income women face in terms of access to education and to jobs with livable wages and benefits which will allow them to support their families. Much of my work has been motivated by the policy shifts which have' contracted the safety net for families, replacing basic assistance with work for welfare programs. Throughout my tenure with the Community Action Board of Santa Cruz County I have had the opportunity to address these issues at the broader policy level, as well as at the local level. I have served on a variety of advisory bodies and worked in coalition with a variety of groups statewide and within the county. I have also had the opportunity to work closely with some of the women who feel the direct impact of those policy choices. As a member of the Women's Commission I would work to ensure that this perspective is included in the work of the Commission, as it addresses issues affecting women in general. I have an interest in making Commission business, and the activities which it sponsors, accessible and relevant to low-income women in Santa Cruz County.
