SUBJECT: CENTRAL COAST RECYCLING MARKET DEVELOPMENT ZONE

Members of the Board:

As you are aware, the County of Santa Cruz is a member of the Central Coast Recycling Market Development Zone (CCRMDZ), along with the counties of Monterey, San Benito, San Luis Obispo, and most cities within these counties. This organization was created in 1994 through a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to encourage and facilitate manufacturing use of recycled materials in the four county regions.

According to the MOU, the administration of the CCRMDZ is to rotate among the member agencies every two years, and the County of Santa Cruz has completed its turn in this role. The new zone administrator is the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority. The Department of Public Works has arranged for transfer of CCRMDZ administrative files and records, including an active contract in the name of the CCRMDZ. As part of these administrative responsibilities, the Department of Public Works has maintained a treasury, as a special agency fund, for the CCRMDZ. The balance in this fund, from grants and annual member dues, is \$37,027.45. It is now necessary to transfer these funds to the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority.

In addition, it will also be necessary to assign an independent contractor's agreement the County holds with Gainer & Associates to the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority. This contract is funded by a State grant to the CCRMDZ. Prior to the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management accepting the assignment, they are requesting that it be approved by the County of Santa Cruz. An assignment form to this effect is attached for your Board's consideration.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following actions:

- 1. Direct the Auditor-Controller to issue a warrant in the name of the Central Coast Recycling Market Development Zone, transferring the Zone treasury balance to the San Luis Obispo County Integrated Waste Management Authority.
- 2. Authorize the Director of Public Works to execute the assignment of the Gainer & Associates contract to the San Luis Obispo Integrated Waste Management Authority.
