LOCATION OF ACCIDENT: SR 17 A7 feet North of MP 1-SCR-11.34. Also known as

the intersection of SR 17 at Old Santa Cruz Highway.

HOW DID ACCIDENT OCCUR:

Claimant was driving his vehicle on SR17 from Santa Cruz towards San Jose. Claimant's vehicle crossed into oncoming traffic and was struck broadside by another vehicle.

The area of this highway at SR 17 and Old Santa Cruz Highway constitutes a dangerous condition of public property in that the dangerous condition created a substantial risk of the type of injury hereinafter stated as the property was used with due care in a manner that was reasonably foreseeable that it would be so used in that claimant drove his vehicle on the roadway, but that the condition of the roadway was so dangerous that it created a substantial risk that claimant would suffer the injuries as hereinafter described.

Further, on the date of this accident, and prior thereto, the highway was in a dangerous condition that created a substantial risk of the type of injury hereinafter stated when the property was used in the manner was reasonably foreseeable in that claimant would drive his vehicle on that roadway and that the curve in the roadway was and is unsafe if taken at the speed limit and that there was no warning sign of such fact and such danger would not be reasonably apparent to and would not have been anticipated by a person using due care such that in addition to the

dangerous nature of the curve there is a dip in the fast lane which claimant was traveling and there was no warning of that dip in the fast lane and further there was no barrier separating the two flows of traffic such that the dangerous condition and the injuries as hereinafter alleged are foreseeable.

DESCRIBE INJURY OR DAMAGE: Claimant sustained bruises, injuries, pain and suffering, head injuries, and continues to suffer depression, anxiety, and general damages.
