SUBJECT: PARKING MANAGEMENT AT THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT CENTER

Dear Members of the Board:

On March 23, 1999 your Board accepted a report on parking management at the County Government Center and directed that the General Services Department report back on May 4, 1999 with further information on installing signs advising of the availability of parking permits and the possibility of using transit passes for jurors.

We currently have two signs in the parking lot advising of the availability of all-day passes. An order has been placed for four additional signs which will be placed at strategic locations to further advertise the program. The additional signs will be installed within the next two weeks. Additionally, staff are in the process of getting feedback from departments on the possibility of installing a drop box at the Government Center. We anticipate having the results of our survey included in our next staff report to your Board.

The use of transit passes for jurors was discussed with the Court Administrator and the Transit District. A system has been developed where jurors will be able to use the portion of their summons which would normally be used as a parking permit and exchange it for an all-day bus pass. Final details on this system are being worked out with the Court and Transit District and following the resolution of these details an agreement will be developed with the Transit District and returned to your Board for final approval. Tt is expected that this agreement can be finalized within the next 30 days.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board:

1. Accept this report; and

2. Direct the General Services Department to return on or before June 15, 1999 with further recommendations.
