Re: Appointment of Membership to Treasury Oversight Commission

Dear Members of the Board,

William P. Murphy has resigned as the public member of the Treasury Oversight Commission, and his replacement needs to be appointed by your Board. Members of this Commission are nominated by the County Treasurer and appointed by the Board of Supervisors. With this letter the County Treasurer nominates Bob Shepherd as Mr. Murphy's replacement.

Government Code §27 13 1 requires each county to establish a Treasury Oversight Committee. Because county ordinance requires that any ongoing committee be a commission, your Board established the Treasury Oversight Commission by passing Chapter 2.119 of the County Code. Pursuant to that Code, the commission shall consist of five members, including "A public member who shall have expertise in, or an academic background in, public finance."

Bob Shepherd meets the requirements of the County Code. He is a Certified Public Accountant, has worked in the County Auditor's Office and was the Director of Finance for the City of Santa Cruz. He is currently teaching accounting to undergraduate and graduate students at the University of California Santa Cruz. Pursuant to §2.119.030 each member of the Commission shall serve for a term of four years. Mr. Murphy is resigning at the end of his term, therefore Mr. Shepherd should be appointed for a four year term.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board appoint Bob Shepherd as the public member of the Treasury Oversight Commission for a term of four years.
