Statement of Qualifications

In nearly 30 years of experience as teacher, businessman and program administrator I have had to deal with many issues which required research, input from diverse groups, communication forums, leadership, coordination, organization, sensitivity and perspective, and decisive decision making. This has required not only knowledge and wisdom but the ability to establish relationships of rapport and respect even in the midst of diverse opinions. Through this process the skills of listening, 'learning, asking the right questions and discernment have been developed.

Over the last nine years I have served as President of PacCom Management Services, Inc., a full-service property management company in Watsonville. While our portfolio of managed properties is diverse, housing has been a major component of our responsibilities.
