### Funding Allocation for Soquel Bridge Replacement Project

Dear Members of the Board:

Soquel Village, a key business area within the Redevelopment Project Area, is located within the floodplain of Soquel Creek. The Soquel Village Plan, developed with extensive community input in the late 1980s, called for the County to take necessary steps to minimize flooding impacts in the Village area.

The Village Plan recognized two specific approaches for reducing flood impacts. The first involved extensive channel modifications and levees. The Army Corps of Engineers evaluated in the early 1990s the potential for such flood-reducing projects, but, because of a shift in funding emphasis by the Corps, those efforts have never been completed. The second approach, and one that is more cost-effective and environmentally sensitive, is to take efforts to modify structures exacerbating flooding in the Village -- including the reconstruction of the Soquel Drive Bridge. This bridge currently serves to constrict the stream channel and traps debris.

Public Works was recently informed that FEMA has awarded the County funding of \$2550,000 towards replacement of this bridge, with a required local match of \$850,000. Public Works during the next month will be bringing to your Board, as the Board of Supervisors, a contract for design services for the bridge reconstruction, with construction anticipated in 2001. The purpose of this letter is to address an Agency contribution towards the overall funding for the project.

Public Works' current project budget anticipates total project costs of \$3.4 million. They are proposing a range of sources to meet the local match requirements, including a contribution from the Agency of \$425,000. Of this funding amount, \$50,000 would need to be available in the current fiscal year to fund a portion of the hydrologic component of

the design services. Adequate funds are available within the Agency's Capital Project reserves to finance the proposed contribution for this project.

Funding of this project meets the requirements of State Redevelopment Law — namely that it will assist in the elimination of blight, consistent with the Redevelopment Plan and the Five Year Implementation Plan, construction will benefit the residents of the project area and the immediate community, and that no other reasonable means of financing are available for the project.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board, as the Board of Directors for the Redevelopment Agency:

- 1. Approve funding of \$425,000 for the Soquel Drive Bridge Replacement Project and adopt the findings included in this letter; and
- 2. Approve the attached AUD 60 accepting and appropriating unanticipated revenues in the current fiscal year for this project.
