SUBJECT: 1999/2000 SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

Members of the Board:

Attached for your Board's review is a notice of public hearing and an ordinance for the proposed 1999/2000 sewer service charge rates. These changes are necessary to comply with Proposition 2 18 and to increase revenue necessary to repay the first year's loan costs of the Davenport Oldtown Sewer Reconstruction Project. This project is intended to alleviate high inflow/infiltration into the system that occurs during times of prolonged heavy rainfall.

The estimated cost of the project is \$885,000. The District has applied for and received a grant from the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development for 75% of project costs, a grant from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) Small Communities Grant Program for approximately 4% of project costs, and a loan from the SWRCB State Revolving Fund Program for the balance. Your Board previously adopted a resolution establishing sewer service charges and/or Capital Improvement Program (CIP) contributions from RMC Lonestar as the dedicated source of revenue to repay this loan. The loan has an interest rate of 2.6% and is payable over 20 years. The repayment is estimated to be \$11,980 per year, 75% of which would be paid by RMC Lonestar per the existing CIP contribution agreement.

Proposition 2 18 requires that the District mail individual notices to all users whose rates are being increased. This notice must be mailed a minimum of 45 days in advance of the public hearing. In order to meet this time line, the attached notice must be mailed by April 2, 1999. Notices will be sent upon your Board's approval.

The proposed sewer service charges for 1999/2000 are as follows:

In order to implement these rates, it is necessary to adopt an ordinance amending District Code for sewer rates. To adopt this ordinance, your Board must first hold a public hearing.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Directors take the following action:

- 1. Set a public hearing for May 18, 1999, at 9:00 a.m. or thereafter to consider adoption of an ordinance amending District Code Title 4, Article III, Section 4.08.160 through 4.08.180, for sewer service charges.
- 2. Direct staff to mail the attached Notice of Public Hearing in accordance with state law as amended by Proposition 218.
- 3. Dire& the Clerk of the Board to publish the attached Notice of Public Hearing, once, at least 45 days prior to the public hearing, and then again once a week for two weeks prior to the hearing in a newspaper of general circulation.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING'DISTRICT CODE TITLE 4, CHAPTER 4.08, ARTICLE HI, SECTIONS 4.08.160 THROUGH 4.08.180 SEWER SERVICE CHARGES

The Board of Directors of the Davenport County Sanitation District DO ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I

Title 4, Chapter 4.08, Article III, Section 4.08 160 through 4.08.180 of the District Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

4.08.160 Amount of charge-Residential facilities. The sewer service charge for each residential facility shall be five hundred sixty-four dollars per year. 4.08.170 Amount of charge--Commercial facilities.

- A. The sewer service charge for each commercial facility or for each separate business within such a facility shall be two hundred one dollars and fifteen cents per year plus four dollars and forty-five cents per hundred cubic feet, based upon the previous calendar year's water use.
- B. In the event that the quality of waste discharge by a commercial facility is of such a character that, in the opinion of the district engineer, it will impose a more than normal maintenance and operation burden on the district works, the amount of the sewer service charge for such commercial facility shall be determined by the board and subsection (a) of this section shall not be applicable to such facility. - 4.08.180 Amount of charge--School facilities, The annual sewer service charge for each school, whether public or private, shall be two hundred one dollars and fifteen cents per year plus eleven dollars and eighty-seven cents per student based on the average daily attendance for the school during the school year. The Board of Directors of the Davenport County Sanitation District DO ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I

Title 4, Chapter 4.08, Article III, Section 4.08 160 through 4.08.180 of the District Code are hereby amended to read as follows:

4.08.160 Amount of charge--Residential facilities. 4.08.170 Amount of charge--Commercial facilities.

A. The sewer service charge for each commercial facility shall be based upon the annual use of water by or for each seuarate business within such a facility and shall be two hundred one dollars and fifteen cents per year plus four dollars and forty-five cents per hundred cubic feet, b a s e d upon the previous cale ndar year's water use. 2

- 1. A charge of five hundred seventy-seven dollars and forty-seven cents per year for each such facility; and
- 2. A charge of three dollars and twenty-three cents per month per one hundred cubic feet, or fraction thereof, over the first fourteen thousand five HCF of water used by such facility.
- B. In the event that the quality of waste discharge by a commercial facility is of such a character that, in the opinion of the district engineer, it will impose a more than normal maintenance and operation burden on the district works, the amount of the sewer service charge for such commercial facility shall be determined by the board and subsection (a) of this section shall not be applicable to such facility. 4.08.180 Amount of charge--School facilities. The annual sewer service charge for each school, whether public or private, shall be thirty dollars and twenty-two cents two hundred one dollars and fifteen cents per year plus eleven dollars and eighty-seven cents per student based on the average daily attendance for the school during the school year.
