## 1999-2000 BENEFIT ASSESSMENT/SERVICE CHARGES FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 9E, STREETSCAPE MAINTENANCE

Dear Members of the Board:

Each year your Board sets the benefit assessment/service charge amounts for the following fiscal year for the county service areas under your jurisdiction. The purpose of this letter is to submit proposed resolutions to establish benefit assessments/service charges for County Service Area No. 9E (CSA 9E) Streetscape Maintenance. It is recommended that your Board set a public hearing to consider adoption of the proposed benefit assessments/service charges and the assessment/service charge reports.

### County Service Area No. 9E

The CSA 9E charge of \$3.08 per single family residence or single commercial parcel, \$1.54 per unit for multi-unit residential or commercial parcel, or \$1.85 for parcels with minor improvements or vacant land is collected from parcels located in the Live Oak/Soquel Redevelopment Project Area. This charge provides for various services to facilitate the long term maintenance of street trees and associated streetscape improvements on major streets within Live Oak and Soquel. In previous years the Department of Public Works administered CSA 9E, while the Redevelopment Agency managed the overall program and maintenance contract. In order to improve efficiency, the Redevelopment Agency has assumed administrative responsibilities as well and is bringing this item before your Board for consideration.

It is recommended that the current charges remain as noted above, the level approved by your Board in 1998-99. Your Board previously approved continuing this charge as an assessment under Proposition 218, in accordance with the February 3, 1997 letter of County Counsel to your Board.

### **Prodedure for Adoption of Service Charges**

Once today's actions have been approved by your Board the Redevelopment Agency will prepare and then place Benefit Assessment/Service Charge reports for County Service Area No. 9E on file with the Clerk of the Board. These reports, containing the Assessor's parcel number, the owner's name, and the amount of the benefit assessment/service charge, will be available on or before July 20, 1999 which will allow for public review two weeks prior to the proposed August 3, 1999 public hearing to consider and adopt the Benefit Assessment/Service Charge Reports. The rate report must be approved by your Board and forwarded to the Auditor-Controller by August 10, 1999.

#### Recommendation

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that your Board take the following actions:

- 1. Adopt the attached resolutions establishing benefit assessment/service charges and setting a public hearing for August 3, 1999, on the proposed benefit assessment/service charges and the proposed 1999-2000 Assessment/Service Charge Reports for County Service Area No. 9E, Streetscape Maintenance; and
- 2. Direct the Clerk of the Board to publish the attached Notice of Public Hearing in the manner prescribed by law.

### A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BENEFIT ASSESSMENT/SERVICE CHARGES FOR THE 1999/2000 FISCAL YEAR FOR COUNTY SERVICE AREA 9E - STREETSCAPE MAINTENANCE

Be it Resolved and Ordered by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz as follows:

Section 1: Benefit Assessments for units and parcels within County Service Area No. 9E Streetscape Maintenance for the 1999/2000 fiscal year, shall be as follows:

\$3.08 per year per single family residence.

\$3.08 per year per single commercial parcel.

\$1.54 per year per unit, multi-unit residential/commercial parcel.

\$1.85 per year per vacant land and parcels with minor improvements.

Section 2: Benefit Assessment Exemptions: Benefit Assessments will not be levied on parcels which are in the following categories:

- 1. Common Area Parcels.
- 2. Parcels with an assessed valuation of \$5,000.00 or less.
- 3. Unbuildable parcels as determined by Planning and Environmental Health regulations. It is the obligation of the parcel owner to provide documentation to verify that a parcel is unbuildable.
- 4. Parcels used solely for, and dedicated to, providing private water supply to residential areas (well or tank sites).
