SUBJECT: BARER ROAD, P.M. 0.05, DSRNO. 99057 AND
HAYWARD DRIVE P.M. 0.05, DSR NO. 99062 STORM DAMAGE REPAIR
COUNTY SERVICE AREA NO. 36 (2ND DISTRICT)

Members of the Board:

The plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate for the subject County Service Area No. 36 project are now complete and presented here for your consideration and approval. The work provides for the repair of storm damage on Baker Road, P.M. 0.05 and Hayward Drive, P.M. 0.05 that occurred during the winter of 1995. This project will provide for the construction of a forty foot long timber pile retaining wall with appurtenant drainage facilities at Baker Road and an underground interceptor drain at Hayward Drive, both of which are in the service area.

The approved Damage Survey Report (DSR) will allow return of the site to its original pre-disaster condition. The plans and specifications thus provide for a repair which essentially matches the existing roadway in the vicinity of the repair site, pursuant to the Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) approved scope of work and available funding. Due to existing physical constraints at the repair site, the new retaining wall requires the use of a flared guardrail on the roadway approaches rather than the new CALTRANS standard. In those instances where the funding approved for a DSR falls short of the actual bid price, we will submit a supplemental funding request to FEMA requesting that they cover the full cost of repair.


The engineer's estimate for this work is \$133,000 including contingencies. Sufficient funding for the project is provided in the 1999/00 budget for CSA No. 36, which includes FEMA and Office of Emergency Services revenues and local match monies.

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It is therefore recommended that the Board of Supervisors take the following action:

1. Approve the plans, specifications, and engineer's estimate and authorize calling for bids.
2. Set the bid opening for 10:45 a.m. on July 20, 1999, in the office of the Director of Public Works.
3. Direct the Clerk of the Board to advertise a Notice to Contractors for a ten day period beginning June 27, 1999, in accordance with the provisions of Public Contract Code Section 20392.
4. Direct Public Works to return to your Board on August 3, 1999, with the results of the bid opening and a recommendation on the award of the contract.


