1999 California Greenways Creative Grants Program Application

Members of the Board:

The California Trails and Greenways Foundation and The Conservation Fund are requesting applications for the 1999 California Greenways Creative Grants Program funding Grant funding is available for planning, design and building of trails and greenways. No local matching funds are required.

We are proposing to submit a project application in the amount of \$2,500 to develop a Sanctuary Scenic Trail informational brochure. (A copy of the application is on tile with the Clerk of the Board.) Due to late notification and an application deadline of June 15, 1999, the grant application was submitted last week, contingent upon your Board's review and approval.

As you are aware, the Santa Cruz County Sanctuary Inter-Agency Task Force was formed to design strategies to masimize the positive economic, interpretive and education benefits that the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary brings to Santa Cruz County. The creation of a scenic bicycle and pedestrian trail system was identified as an important first step toward achieving these goals. The Sanctuary Scenic Trail will provide a major opportunity to link transportation, environmental, recreational, cultural and educational elements and major activity centers of the region as well as to unify our County's waterfront areas.

This project application would fund development of an informational brochure to bring attention to the Sanctuary Scenic Trail and the associated interpretive and waytinding program. The brochure will be developed by the County Planning Department's Geographic Information System planners. The grant funds will be used to pay for staff costs as well as duplication services.

It is therefore RECOMMENDED that the Board of Supervisors **ratify** the Planning Director's submittal of the California Greenways Creative Grants Program application in the amount of \$2,500 on behalf of the County and adopt the attached resolution approving the County's participation in the application.
