TO COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ:

- 1. Application is hereby made for leave to present a late claim under Section 9 11.4 of the Government Code. The claim is founded on a cause of action for general negligence, premises liability, trespass, and nuisance, which accrued on December 5, 1998, and for which a claim was not timely presented. For additional circumstances relating to the cause of action, reference is made to the proposed claim attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.
- 2. The reason for the delay in presenting this claim is the mistake and inadvertence of the claimant and Robert E. Wall, Esquire, as is more particularly shown in the Declaration of Robert E. Wall, Esquire, attached hereto and made a part hereof. COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ was not prejudiceh in the defense of the claim by the failure to file the claim in a timely manner, as shown by the De&ration of Robert E. Wall.
- 3. This application is presented within a reasonable time after the accrual of the cause of acti on as shown by the declaration of Robert E. Wall.

DECLARATION OF ROBERT E. WALL

I, Robert E. Wall, declare:

- 1. I am a shareholder at the law firm of Grunsky, Ebey, Farrar & Howell, APC, duly admitted to practice before all the courts of the State of California, and am the attorney of record rerein for plaintiff STATE FARM GENERAL INSURANCE COMPANY.
- 2. On June 24, 1999, the delay in presenting this claim against the COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ was discovered.
- 3. The purpose of the statute requiring presentation of claims against a governmental entity (Gov. Code § 911.2) is to give the entity notice and an opportunity to investigate and settle meritorious claims without investigation.
- 4. This application is made within a reasonable time, less than 20 days after the 6-month presentation deadline for claims required by Government Code § 911.2 and with reasonable diligence after discovering the default only two days earlier.
- 5. The COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ should not be prejudiced in any way by this delay as they were already on notice of this dispute as a party to the quiet title action, Case No. 134227, filed July 2, 1998 in the County of Santa Cruz.
