SUBJECT: 1999/2000 ZONE 5 BUDGET

Members of the Board:

As directed by your Board during budget hearings on June 18, 1999, we return today with the following additional detail on the approved fiscal year 1999/2000 Zone 5 budget. Fiscal year 1998199 expenditure detail through March 5, 1999, will be provided under separate cover prior to the August 3, 1999, meeting.

MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS

Maintenance and Operations \$3 12.000

This item pays for crew time, equipment, and supplies for doing maintenance work on Zone 5 drainage facilities, such as clearing channels, storm drain inlets and pipelines, repair of and minor construction of same, etc.

<u>Emergency Flood Control Services \$60.000</u> The amount budgeted for this item is for emergency work during winter rains.

<u>County Counsel Services \$10.000</u> These funds pay for services from County Counsel concerning ongoing operations of Zone 5.

<u>Accounting and Audit Fees \$4.266</u> This item pays for accounting and related administrative services for the Zone.

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Contingencies \$84.305

These funds, not committed to a specific project or service, are held in reserve to augment the committed funds in other items when necessary and to deal with unexpected maintenance and operations responsibilities which often arise.

EXPANSION/CONSTRUCTION

General Engineering and Public Service \$80.000

Engineering staff time to perform the duties and responsibilities of the Zone is funded from this item.

Permit Processing \$26.933

This budget item funds the drainage review of development permits in the Zone.

Field Inspection \$20,500

Field inspection of development projects proposed and under construction within the Zone is funded **from** this item.

Master Plan \$25,000

Additional analysis and implementation of the Storm Water Facilities Management System developed as part of the Master Plan will be paid for out of this item.

Soquel Creek Sand Bar Removal \$45.000

This budget item pays for crew time and equipment for removal of the Soquel Creek Sand Bar located under the Soquel Drive Bridge.

Water Resources Monitoring - Urban Runoff \$30.000

Development and enforcement of storm water management and urban runoff standards and practices for required County permitting, private development, and County operations will be funded from this budget item.

Minor Projects \$30.000

This item pays for staff design and construction services in connection with small projects which may arise during the year in the Zone.

Soauel Creek Hydraulic Study \$64,522

The hydraulic study of Soquel Creek is funded from this item in conjunction with the Soquel Drive Bridge Replacement Project.

Monterey Avenue Storm Drain \$50.000

This budget item pays the Zone 5 portion of the Monterey Avenue Storm Drain project. The original project, now nearly complete, was modified so that it may be extended with a second phase.

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Master Plan CIP Improvements \$169,000

Zone 5 Capital Improvement Program projects are represented by this budget item. The amount budgeted in this item will allow Zone 5 to design and build projects that are on the current CIP list identified in the Master Plan, which will be brought to the Board on August 24, 1999.

It is therefore recommended that the Board of Directors accept and file this report **containing** additional details of the 199912000 Zone 5 Budget.
