Main Jail Security Upgrade Project (917105) - Phase II

Dear Members of the Board:

As your Board is aware, construction is now underway at the Main Jail as part of the security upgrade project (417105). One element of the second phase of this project is the installation of replacement sally port doors at the in-custody garage entrance used by sworn law enforcement officers. After careful analysis of the design work and improved operational security efficiencies currently underway, only a single product for the sally port doors themselves will work as specified in the design. This hydraulic product is only available from A & D Automatic Gate Company of Redwood City representing manufacturer Electric Power Door. Both the project engineer/security consultant and County facilities management have reviewed the product and are confident that it will meet the County's security upgrade requirements.

Funding for this acquisition has been included within the project budget. In order to acquire the doors within the project time line and in accordance with County purchasing procedures, your Board's authorization is necessary in order to directly negotiate the purchase of these doors from the vendor as a sole source item

It is therefore **RECOMMENDED** that your Board authorize the General Services staff to negotiate the purchase of the Main Jail replacement sally port doors from A & D Automatic Gate Company of Redwood City at a not to exceed price of \$90,000 as part of the Main Jail Security Upgrade Project (417105) - Phase II.


