- Circumstances of occurrence or transaction giving rise to claim: Damage to Real Property known as APN-049-022-58 by County of Santa Cruz, Drainage Improvements to White Road most recently water piped 500 yards away from White Rd., across intervening property. The County piped surface water drainage from White Rd. through our neighbor's property to our property.
- 4. General description of indebtedness, obligation, injury, damage or loss incurred so far as is now known: The property is being physically invaded by surface water runoff diverted onto the property by pipes constructed and maintained by the County and the property is being eroded and physically washed away by the surface water runoff. There is elimination in value to the amount of land eroded away and the reduction in fair market property value due to the reluctance of a prospective buyer to pay full value given the ongoing erosion and use of the property as a drainage way outside the usual streambed.
