WHEREAS, Article XVI, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of California provides that it shall be the duty of the Treasurer of any county to provide funds for meeting the obligations incurred for operation and maintenance purposed by any political subdivision whose funds are in his custody and are paid solely through his office: and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the sums <u>listed below</u> be transferred from the funds in the custody of the Treasurer of the County of Santa Cruz to the <u>Districts listed below</u> for meeting the obligations incurred for operation and maintenance of the Districts through the <u>dates listed below</u>.

1. That the Treasurer of the County of Santa Cruz be and is hereby authorized and directed to					

- transfer from the funds in his custody to the <u>district listed above</u> the sums as <u>listed above</u>, said sums to be used for meeting the obligations incurred for operation and maintenance purposed only for said District.
- 2. Said transfer of sums shall be made by the Treasurer of the County of Santa Cruz only to the extent that said sums as <u>listed above</u> do not exceed 85% of the taxes accruing to said District before any other obligations of said District are met from such tax. Such repayment shall be with interest at the rate received on similar investments by the County on the date this Resolution is adopted, as determined by the County Treasurer, or the cost of borrowing, whichever is greater.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE APTOS/LA SELVA FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT TO REQUEST A TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF FUNDS

whereas, the Aptos/La Selva Fire Protection District may be in need of financial assistance during the period of July 1, 1999 to April 24, 2000; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz, by Resolution 616-67, declared its approval of and intention to provide needed tax anticipation funds pursuant to Constitution Article XVI, Section 6;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Directors of the Aptos/La Selva Fire Protection District hereby determines and declares that:

- 1. The sum of two million five hundred thousand (\$2,500,000) dollars may be needed in anticipation of Service Charge Revenues for the operation and maintenance of said district through April 26, 2000.
- 2. Said sum of \$2,500,000 requested does not exceed 85% of the anticipated Service Charge Revenues for the tax year.
- 3. The District agrees to repay this loan by April 2, 2000 together with interest at the current rate per annum received on similar types of investments by the county as determined by the County Treasurer.
- 4. The Secretary to this Board shall forward three certified copies of this resolution to the Auditor-Controller of the County of Santa Cruz so that the request may be signed and presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval.

RESOLUTION #1998/99-27 REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY TRANSFER OF FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Live Oak School District is in need of financial assistance during the period of July 1, 1999 to April 30, 2000;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Santa Cruz has, by Resolution 616-67, declared its approval of an intention to provide needed tax anticipation funds pursuant to Constitution Article XVI, Section 6;

NOW, THEREPORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Governing Board of the Live Oak School District hereby determines and declares that:

- 1. The sum of \$700,000 dollars is needed in anticipation of tax revenues for the operation and maintenance of said district until tax revenues are collected for the fiscal year.
- 2. Said sum of \$700,000 does not exceed 85% of the anticipated tax revenues for the tax year.
- 3. The District agrees to repay this loan from the first tax revenue together with interest at the current rate per annum received on similar types of investments by the county as determined by the County Treasurer.
- 4. The secretary to this board shall forward three certified copies of this resolution to the Auditor-Controller of the County of Santa Cruz so that the request may be signed and presented to the Board of Supervisors for approval.
