### STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS

Civil Service Commission Cheryl L. Zozaya

My name is Cheryl Zozaya. I have lived and worked in Santa Cruz County for 14 years. I reside in Watsonville, and have three children who attended Pajaro Valley Schools. I worked for the Pajaro Valley Unified School District for six years, and have worked at Cabrillo College for almost seven years. I have volunteered in the community in a number of capacities – for the Literacy Volunteers of Pajaro Valley and the United Way, and I currently serve as a Board member for La Alianza, a non-profit organization that provides services to cannery and farm workers. And since 1997, I have been a member of the Personnel Commission for the City of Watsonville. As a parent and community member, I am very interested in the future of Santa Crut County and in meeting the needs of its citizens.

I recently completed my bachelor's degree at the University of Phoenix, majoring in Business Administration. One area of study for my degree focused on personnel administration, which is an area of interest to me. While working in the Superintendent's Office at the Pajaro Valley Unified School District, and now in the President's Office at Cabrillo College, I have had a lot of interaction with Personnel Departments, serving on hiring committees and participating in salary studies. I have also learned a great deal about personnel issues through my position on the Personnel Commission for the City of Watsonville.
